

Adult Scorekeeping in GEVA – 2009 Season

There are two levels of adult scorekeeper certification that can be earned in GEVA.

Provisional Scorekeeper - tested and awarded at the local level
Regional Scorekeeper - tested and awarded at the local level

Scorekeeper certification consists of two parts;

1. Candidates must take a written test covering the rules for and techniques of scorekeeping. All of the information covered is contained in the USAV rulebook.
2. Following successful passing of the written test the candidate must keep score at sanctioned tournament and mail the scoresheets in for evaluation.

As a reminder, Adult GEVA teams planning to play in Regionals that have two certified Scorekeepers on their roster by March 15, 2009 will be eligible for a discount on the Regional entry fee.

The following are the requirements and guidelines necessary to become a GEVA Scorekeeper. Candidates must start at the Qualification or Provisional level. After a provisional rating is earned, a candidate may upgrade to the Regional level the following season.

Provisional Scorekeeper -

- a. Obtain a passing grade of 85 on the Scorekeepers B Test open book exam. The test is downloaded, taken and mailed to the Adult Scorekeeper Coordinator for correction.
- b. Following receipt of a passing grade by return mail/email, keep score at a regular season sanctioned tournament for three games, one of which must be a deciding game. The completed scoresheets will be mailed to the Adult Scorekeeper Coordinator for review.
- c. Upon completion of the process a Provisional Scorekeeper's rating will be granted.
- d. This rating is valid for the **current season and the following season.**

Regional Scorekeeper -

- a. Obtain a passing grade of 90 on the Scorekeepers A Test, open book exam. The test is taken online at (["http://www.yankee.org/scorers/usavtest"](http://www.yankee.org/scorers/usavtest)). The password for the test is **GEH979S**. No correction is required.

- b. Following receipt of a passing grade by return email, keep score at a regular season sanctioned tournament for three games, one of which must be a deciding game. The scoresheets should show ability to handle substitutions. The completed scoresheets will be mailed to the Adult Scorekeeper Coordinator for review.
- c. Upon completion of the process a Regional Scorekeeper's certification rating will be granted.
- d. This rating is valid for the **current season and the following two seasons.**
